Appointment to public art selection panel

Boffa Miskell landscape architect William Field has been appointed to a new curatorial group that will select artworks for SCAPE 2010 – the sixth Christchurch Biennial of art in public space event run by the Art & Industry Biennial Trust in Christchurch.

The Trust aims to engage people's interest and involvement in art by locating permanent and temporary artworks in public spaces. Over the last ten years, it has gifted six permanent artworks to the city and commissioned more than 150 temporary public artworks.

The curatorial group of three will select and work with artists to produce the public artworks for the September - November 2010 event. More than two-thirds of the artworks will be by New Zealand artists and a number of them will be targeted specifically at involving the community.

William, who has had a long-standing interest in public art, will bring his landscape design skills and knowledge of the Christchurch urban scene to the group.
